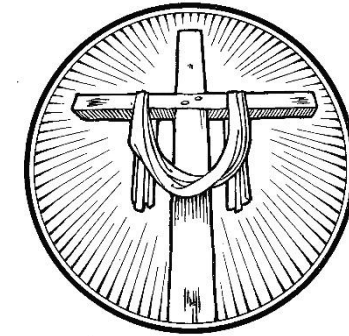

Announcements

The movement is made by one man, but it is a movement of the whole Church. This is fitting, because it serves to remind us that the whole Church is one, united in the one man Jesus Christ. It is also appropriate, therefore, for everyone to make the sign of the holy cross as the celebrant enters the holy place (the chancel), or even, as is the custom of some, to make the sign three times: once, as the celebrant begins his walk, again, as he passes into the chancel, and again, as he arrives, genuflects, and kisses the altar. This is in token that it is because of our baptismal faith that we stand united in one Christ, and enter with Him into the presence of His Father, as signified by the entrance of the celebrant.
