 Distinguish between the true and the false worship of God. True worship of God is only such as conforms in spirit and expression with God's revelation of Himself. Read John 4:24. All worship is false which seeks communion with God in ways other than those which He has appointed. False worship is either:

 (a) The paying of divine honors to false god, such idolatry (the Hindoos), nature-worship (the Greeks), ancestor-worship


